Mini Grants Are Back

Kumu's Cupboard will once again offer mini grants for the Fall semester. The mini grants are a great way to get supplies for a special project, needed and wanted materials for the classroom, and items to enhance your teaching.

Grants are up to \$250 per educator. New this year, if you have a project that exceeds the \$250 limit, you may contact Elyse Litvack at kumuscupboard1@gmail.com or 808-647-6989 to find out how to request an increase in the grant amount.

The grant application is designed to be quick and easy to complete. Providing resources and/or links for the items you want is very helpful. Grants are up to \$250 per educator. Grants will be accepted between August 11th and August 24th. You will be notified if your grant is funded. Once you are notified that your grant materials are at Kumu's Cupboard, we ask that you pick them up within a two-week period. See the grant application attached to this newsletter.

Mini Grant Application
August 2025

The mini grants are available to help provide materials for teaching a unit or doing a project or getting needed supplies for your classroom. Applications are accepted August 11th – August 24th, 2025. Grant applications must be submitted through email at: kumuscupboard1@gmail.com.

Grants are for up to \$250 per applicant. If you have a project or need supplies that exceed this amount, please contact Elyse Litvack at: kumuscupboard1@gmail.com or 808-647-6989. We have \$8,000 allocated for this project. If completed applications exceed the allotment, we will select the projects to be funded although grants may be funded in the order received.

Applicants agree that they will pick up the materials within two weeks of notification that they are available, and that they will teach the unit or use the materials during the Fall semester of the 2025-2026 school year. Applicants understand that they will be required to complete a grant agreement when picking up supplies and then complete and return a simple grant evaluation no later than December 15, 2025.
